## STIPULATION AMENDING THE SCHEDULING ORDER ON JURISDICTIONAL DISCOVERY

Plaintiff Irving H. Picard (the "Trustee"), as trustee for the substantively consolidated liquidation proceeding of Bernard L. Madoff Investment Securities LLC under the Securities Investor Protection Act, 15 U.S.C. §§ 78aaa–*Ill*, and the chapter 7 estate of Bernard L. Madoff,

and defendant Lion Global Investors Limited ("Defendant," and with the Trustee, the "Parties"), by and through their respective undersigned counsel, state as follows:

**WHEREAS,** on July 17, 2025, the Court entered an Amended Scheduling Order for jurisdictional discovery (the "Scheduling Order");

WHEREAS, the Scheduling Order set forth the following briefing schedule after the completion of jurisdictional discovery: (i) a deadline of August 18, 2025, for the Trustee to file either a supplemental memorandum in opposition to the motion to dismiss or a motion for leave to amend the complaint; (ii) a deadline of October 17, 2025, for the Defendant to file an opposition to the Trustee's memorandum or opposition to the motion; and (iii) a deadline of November 17, 2025, in the event the Trustee files a motion for leave to amend the complaint, the Trustee shall file a reply in further support of his motion;

**WHEREAS,** a Status Conference and a hearing on Defendant's Motion to Dismiss is scheduled for December 18, 2025;

**WHEREAS,** the Parties completed jurisdictional discovery and are currently engaged in discussions to determine whether they may be able to negotiate a resolution to this matter;

WHEREAS, the Parties therefore agree to extend all deadlines as well as the Status Conference and Hearing by 30 days so that they may diligently work together in an attempt to resolve this matter; and

## NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

- The Trustee shall file either a supplemental memorandum in opposition to the motion to dismiss or a motion for leave to amend the complaint by September 17, 2025;
- Defendant shall file an opposition to the Trustee's memorandum or opposition to the motion by November 17, 2025;

- 3. In the event the Trustee files a motion for leave to amend the complaint, the Trustee shall file a reply in further support of his motion by **December 17, 2025**;
- 4. The Status Conference scheduled for **December 18, 2025**, has been adjourned to the Court's **January 2026 omnibus hearing date**.
- 5. The Hearing on Defendant's Motion to Dismiss scheduled for **December 18, 2025**, has been adjourned to the Court's **January 2026 omnibus hearing date**.
