

WHEREAS, on March 11, 2026, Malcolm Sage and Lynne Florio (together, the “Defendants”) filed a Motion for Extension of Time to Respond [ECF 150] seeking a 90-day extension of the Objection Deadline, to which the Trustee responded via letter filed on March 16, 2026 [ECF 151]; and

WHEREAS, after carefully considering the circumstances, the Court finds a brief extension – as contemplated herein – of the Objection Deadline to be reasonable.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

1. The Objection Deadline is extended to **no later than 5 P.M (EST) on April 15, 2026**.
2. The extension of the Objection Deadline contemplated herein shall be with prejudice, and the Court will not grant any further extension of the Objection Deadline.
3. Any such objection must be in the form of a pleading in conformance with the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure, the Bankruptcy Rules and the Local Bankruptcy Rules.
4. If the Defendants do not file an objection conforming to this Order by the Objection Deadline, the Court shall grant the Motion without holding a hearing.
5. If the Defendants file an objection conforming to this Order, any reply by the Trustee shall be filed **no later than 5 P.M. on April 22, 2026**, and a hearing shall be held, via Zoom for Government, **at 10 AM (EST) on April 29, 2026**. All parties wishing to attend or appear at the Hearing must register through the following webpage: <https://www.nysb.uscourts.gov/ecourt-appearances>, no later than 4 PM on the day prior to the Conference. Should Defendants wish to request an in-person hearing, such request should be made in writing, no later than the Objection Deadline, to the Court and the Trustee. Upon receipt of such request, the Court shall hold a hearing **at 11 AM (EST) on April 29, 2026** at Courtroom 623, United States Bankruptcy Court, One Bowling Green, New York, New York 10004.

6. The Court retains jurisdiction over all matters related to or arising out of the implementation and execution of this Order.
