

WHEREAS, on March 11, 2026, Malcolm Sage and Lynne Florio (together, the “Defendants”) filed a Motion for Extension of Time to Respond [ECF 150] seeking a 90-day extension of the Objection Deadline; and

WHEREAS, on March 17, 2026, the Court issued an order [ECF 153] (the “Order”) extending the Objection Deadline to April 15, 2026 and establishing related procedures for considering any potential objection to the Motion; and

WHEREAS, on March 18, 2026, the Defendants filed a letter [ECF 155] requesting, *inter alia*, further extension of the Objection Deadline and reconsideration of the procedures provided for in the Order; and

WHEREAS, the Court has considered the various requests for relief in the Defendants’ letter and finds them meritless.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

1. The relief requested in the Defendants’ letter dated March 18, 2026 is **DENIED**, and all terms of the Order remain in full force and effect.
2. For avoidance of doubt, if the Defendants wish for the Court to hold a hearing to consider any opposition to the Motion, the Defendants must file an objection to the Motion by the Objection Deadline, and such objection must be in the form of a pleading in conformance with the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure, the Bankruptcy Rules and the Local Bankruptcy Rules.
3. As provided for in the Order, if the Defendants file such an objection, any reply by the Trustee shall be filed **no later than 5 P.M. on April 22, 2026**, and a hearing shall be held, via Zoom for Government, **at 10 AM (EST) on April 29, 2026**. All parties wishing to attend or appear at the Hearing must register through the following webpage: <https://www.nysb.uscourts.gov/ecourt-appearances>, no later than 4 PM on the day prior to the

Conference. Should Defendants wish to request an in-person hearing, such request should be made in writing, no later than the Objection Deadline, to the Court and the Trustee. Upon receipt of such request, the Court shall hold a hearing **at 11 AM (EST) on April 29, 2026** at Courtroom 623, United States Bankruptcy Court, One Bowling Green, New York, New York 10004.

4. The Court retains jurisdiction over all matters related to or arising out of the implementation and execution of this Order.
